### **CATHEDRAL CHAPTER - CANONS**

In the past, the Cathedral Chapter had a consultative role in advising the Bishop. Nowadays it has no practical function whatsoever. Instead, the elected Council of Priests is the main body that advises the Bishop along with the Diocesan Pastoral Council.

Happily, titles such as Canon that were associated with the Chapter have fallen into disuse and in many Dioceses have been abolished.
